# Meets a SUNY General Education requirement

Pre-requisites for Admission to Psychology Major:

In addition to PSY101, courses comparable to Albany’s PSY210 (Statistical Methods in Psychology) and PSY211 (Experimental Psychology) must be satisfactorily completed with a grade of “C” or better before formal admission to the major can be granted. When feasible, ACC students are encouraged to cross-register at SUNY ALBANY for PSY210 and PSY211; or register for both courses during the summer before your Fall admittance.

Transfers entering with only PSY101 will be advised by the Psychology Department as PROPOSED Psychology majors. They will be directed to enroll in PSY210 for the first semester and PSY211 for the second semester.
