



Early Admission Program

The College has established an Early Admission Program in accordance with State Education Department guidelines in order to provide academically capable high school seniors an opportunity to take college level courses. These guidelines require an average of 85% or higher in a Regents course of study and the recommendation of the high school guidance counselor or principal. Home schooled seniors who have an 85% average or better must provide a recommendation from a designated school official within the agency/association providing the curriculum for high school study. The school official must indicate the student's current grade level and high school average.

High school juniors/home schooled juniors will be considered under the same standards on a part time basis only, and with the written request and recommendation of the high school principal/designated school official.

Early Admission applications are available from the high school guidance counselor or from the Office of Admissions at ACC and must be completed each semester.

All applicants must attach an official copy of the high school transcript to the application. Applicants for full-time study must submit a one page essay with their applications explaining their reasons for wanting to study in the Early Admissions Program at ACC. Once the completed application is on file, an interview will be arranged with the Admissions staff.

All decisions are at the discretion of the Director of Enrollment Management.

Federal and State Legislation currently prevent Early Admission students from receiving any State or Title IV Federal Student Aid.
