Winter Enrichment Program

For area youths in grades 4-6

This four day program will be offered again at SUNY Adirondack during the public school mid winter recess break in February. Taught by four instructors who have taught in the Summer Enrichment Program for years, the program is designed to give area youth in grades 4 through 6 an enrichment opportunity during the winter school break week. Children can register for one, two or three classes offered during three different time slots, 8:15-10:15, 10:30-12:30 or 1:00-3:00. Children should not be on campus during a time in which they are not registered for a class. During the half-hour lunch break, children will eat the lunches they bring from home. All classes will take place in Washington Hall.

A student can enroll if he or she has an overall "B" average or higher OR scores in the 90th percentile on any state or national standardized test. A School Principal/Teacher Certification Form must be included with the registration form for those students who HAVE NOT attended the Winter Enrichment Program last year, or the Summer Enrichment Program in either of the last two years. - Live Exotic Animals – Up close with a python, alligator, giant tortoise, lizards and more.

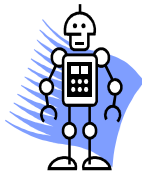

Introduction to Mindstorm – LEGO Robotics

Here's a class where you get to combine both your love for computers and LEGOS to make a functioning ROBOT! In this class you will:

- Use Mindstorm computer software to program your robot
- Build your robot out of LEGO motors, gears and sensors
- Check out your programming skills– transmit your program to the robot (this is done with Infrared waves)
- Perform a test run to see if your robot accomplishes what you wanted it to
- Problem-solve, debug your program, or make enhancements for better robot performance
- Go from a stack of LEGO parts to a robot in just four classes

2012 Winter Enrichment Registration Information

THERE ARE FOUR WAYS TO REGISTER YOUR CHILD FOR THE WINTER ENRICHMENT PROGRAM:

1. WALK-IN REGISTRATION

Walk-in registration is Monday-Friday, 8:00 am-4:00 pm daily in Continuing Education in **Washington Hall** at SUNY Adirondack in Queensbury. Note: Payment in cash or with a credit card must be made at the Business Office in Warren Hall **AFTER** registering for courses in Washington Hall.

2. MAIL-IN REGISTRATION

Mail-in registration Please send registration materials and payment to: Continuing Education, SUNY Adirondack, 640 Bay Road, Queensbury, NY 12804.

3. FACSIMILE (FAX) REGISTRATION.

If registering by **FAX**, send completed registration materials and payment (VISA, MC, Discover) to 743-2318.

4. TELEPHONE REGISTRATION.

Telephone registrations will be accepted using a VISA, MC, Discover **only** if student has attended the Winter Enrichment Program last year, or the Winter/Summer Enrichment Program in the last two years (Medical Release Form is required.)

OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

- A. Students must currently be enrolled in 4, 5, 6 grade to be eligible for the program.
- B. If you register your child for more than one class, these classes must meet consecutively in time—that is, you may register your child for an 8:15 am and then a 10:30 am class, but you may NOT register your child for an 8:15 am class and then a 1:00 pm class. Children should not be on campus during a time in which they are not registered for a class. Example, if your child's first class is at 10:30 am, he or she should NOT be on campus before 10:15 am. Please pick children up promptly after their last class of the day.
- C. To enroll your child, you **MUST** submit the following: (1) a completed Registration Form; (2) School Principal/Teacher Certification Form, **if applicable** (including the required signatures verifying eligibility), (3) a completed Medical Release Form; (4) payment of tuition and fees by VISA, MasterCard, Discover, or check (payable to ACC). If you are registering in person, payments in cash or with a credit card must be made at the Business Office in Warren Hall after registering for courses in Washington Hall. **NOTE:** If your child has been enrolled in the Winter Enrichment Program or the Summer Enrichment Program in either of the last two (2) years, it is not necessary for you to submit the signed School Principal/Teacher Certification Form.
- D. If a class is canceled, students will be notified by telephone.

Our refund policy is: 100% course tuition and fees refund prior to 4:00 pm on Friday, February 10.

No refunds will be issued after 4:00 pm on Friday, February 10.
