COMMUNICATION DISORDERS

The Department of Communication Disorders offers two major programs: a Liberal Arts major and a Speech Education major. The liberal arts major prepares students for graduate study in speech-language pathology, audiology and related areas. The speech education major (speech and language disabilities) has been registered to meet the New York State requirements for the initial certificate as a Teacher of Students with Speech and Language Disabilities. This unique program is linked to the graduate program in Speech-Language Pathology.
