Such person shall upon his registration for each college year, file with the college such a certificate of residence issued not earlier than two months prior thereto, and such certificate of residence shall be valid for a period of one year from the date of issuance."

*Education Law, Section 6301, paragraph 4, defines: "Resident" A person who has resided in the state for a period of at least one year in the county, city, town, intermediate school district or school district as the case may be for a period of at least six months, both immediately preceding the date of such a person's registration in a community collge, or for the purpose of section sixty three hundred five of this chapter, his application for a certificate of residence.
